- Confirmed, practicing Catholic in goodstanding
- spiritually qualified, mature
- able to be present to the candidate as s/he grows in faith
- able to continue to be a sign and support of faith to candidate
- participated in the preparation of the candidate.

Candidates, examine your Confirmation Name essay.

- 2. Did you respond adequately to each of the 5-6 bullet-point questions?
- Who is/are your favorite saint(s). Why?

- Name saints and Christian holy people who have had your Baptismal name or the name you have chosen as your Confirmation name -<u>http://www.catholic.org/saints/,</u> <u>http://saints.sqpn.com/alphabetical-list/,</u> or other source.
- What is the meaning of your Baptismal and/or new Confirmation name? <u>http://name-meanings.com/</u>, or other source.

If a new Confirmation name –

- How/why does this new name express your desire to indicate the beginning of a new relationship to Jesus Christ and the Church?
- How/why is the name a Christian name?

If you are keeping your Baptismal name -

- State why you decided to keep it as your Confirmation name expanding on the "expression of intimate relationship of Confirmation with Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation)"; and/or your relationship with Jesus Christ and the Church; and any other reasons.
- Please state sources.

Place a mark by any question that you did not answer or could have answered more completely.

Improve upon any part of any of the essays that could use it.

Share your essays with your Sponsor.

3. Ask your sponsor to read, write comments on and sign the essays.

#### **<u>Rite of Confirmation - Gospels</u>**

We begin selection of readings for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The following Gospels are the options for the Confirmation Mass.

(We have heard most of them now, all but 4.)

Read them all.

Gospel:

1) Mt. 5:1-12a – Beatitudes – "*theirs is the kingdom of heaven*".

2) Mt. 16: 24-27 – Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself.

3) Mt. 25: 14-30 – the talents – *Since you were faithful in small matters, come, share your master's joy.* 

4) Mk. 1: 9-11 – Jesus saw the Spirit descending upon him.

5) Lk. 4:16-22a – *The Spirit of the Lord is upon me.* 

6) Lk. 8:4-10a, 11b-15 – The seed that fell on rich soil: they are the ones who, when they have heard the Word, bear fruit through perseverance.

7) Lk. 10:21-24 – *I give you praise Father, for you have revealed hidden things to the childlike.* 

8) Jn. 7:37b-39 – *Rivers of living water will flow*.

9) Jn. 14: 15-17 – *The Spirit of truth will remain with you.* 

10) Jn. 14:23-26 – *The Holy Spirit will teach you everything*.

11) Jn. 15:18-21, 26-27 – When the Spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father comes, he will testify to me.

12) Jn. 16:5-7, 12-13a – The Spirit of truth will guide you to all truth.

4. Which Gospel would you hope would be selected for Confirmation and why?
